

It is hereby ordered that the following schedules of costs are adopted for Administrative Hearings per case.

Where total fines are less than \$100.00		\$40.00
If a Motion to Set Aside a Default Determination of Liability based on good cause is granted	Add	\$10.00
If the Case is Bifurcated	Add	\$10.00
Where total fines are \$100.00 or less than \$500.00		\$75.00
If a Motion to Set Aside a Default Determination Of Liability based on good cause is granted	Add	\$30.00
If the Case is Bifurcated	Add	\$30.00
Where total fines are \$500.00 or less than \$1,000.00		\$100.00
If a Motion to Set Aside a Default Determination of Liability based on good cause is granted	Add	\$60.00
If the Case is Bifurcated	Add	\$60.00
Where total fines are \$1,000.00 or more		\$200.00
If a motion to Set Aside a Default Determination of Liability based on good cause is granted	Add	\$90.00
If the Case is Bifurcated	Add	\$90.00

Costs assessed pursuant to this general order are issued by the authority of the Cook County Administrative Hearing Act 09-0-03, Section 2-904 (a) (10), and shall be earmarked for the purpose of conducting administrative hearings, including necessary technology and ancillary courtroom space.
