GENERAL ORDER NO. 2009-4.1

Under Sec 2-903 of Article IX. Administrative Hearings, The Director of Administrative hearings has the power and duty to:

(a) Direct the department with respect to its management and structure, including the creation or reorganization of hearing divisions within the department;

(b) Establish any other necessary rules and regulations as may be required to carry out the provisions of this chapter.

In keeping with the powers and duties under Sec 2-903, The Director of Administrative Hearings has been authorized from The Cook County Board President to utilize the area, designated by the markings of #1182 in The County Building at 119 N. Clark Chicago, IL as Administrative Hearing Room for the Adjudication of Administrative Complaints brought forth by the County of Cook and its departments.

Any unauthorized disruption in and/or denial of the full usage of any of the space designated by the Director impedes the Administrative Law Judges ability to meet their duties to exercise their powers and administer justice.

It is hereby ORDERED that Administrative Law Judges shall have the power and duty to ensure that the area marked of #1182 at 119 N. Clark Chicago, IL shall remain free of any unauthorized disruptions and/or any denial of full usage of the designated area.

THIS ORDER BECOMES EFFECTIVE UPON THE SIGNING BY THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS.
