

## CONDITIONS FOR HAUL PERMIT

1. That the said applicant, its successor or assignee shall assume all risk and liability for accidents and damages that may accrue to persons and property, during the prosecution of the work or any time thereafter, and that said applicant agrees to claims for damages and from all costs and expenses incurred on account thereof, and in connection therewith.
2. That this permit is effective insofar only as the department has jurisdiction and does not presume to release said applicant from compliance with the provisions of any existing statutes relating to this movement.
3. That this move meets all the latest rules and regulations of the State of Illinois.
4. That due to the high traffic volumes on two lane highways, there is a time limit from 9:30 AM to 3:00 PM on all highway usage, and the time limit on all four lanes is from sunrise to sunset. On Saturdays and the day before national holidays, the time limit for all hauls is from 9:00 AM to NOON.
5. That the Permittee equipment operations shall be conducted in a manner to insure the minimum hindrance to traffic using the pavements and at no time shall the operations obstruct more than one-half of the available pavement widths unless, in the instance of transporting over-size equipment, it is escorted by an official police vehicle and said equipment and/or load is clearly marked with flags, etc.
6. That the use of flagmen and that the number, type, color, size and placement of all traffic control devices shall conform to the latest edition of the State of Illinois "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways."
7. That the pavements shall be kept clean and free of debris at all times.
8. That the equipment, load or object to be transported will not be loaded nor parked neither day or night upon the highway without specific permission from the Cook County Highway Department.
9. That if the applicant's usage of said highway causes failure in the base course or bituminous pavement thereon, said applicant should immediately and at his own expense repair said failures.
10. IF AT ANY TIME DURING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS PERMIT, CONSTRUCTION BEGINS ON THE ROAD(S) MENTIONED HEREIN, THIS PERMIT WILL THEN BECOME NULL AND VOID.
11. This Permit can be revoked, at any time, at the discretion of the Superintendent of the Cook County Highway Department.

13. It is the responsibility of the permittee to inspect all grade crossings for clearance along the permitted route prior to a move. Furthermore, the permittee assumes sole responsibility and indemnifies the Highway Department at no cost to Cook County.
